

Amber Valley Cider Pub of the Year 2022 Nominations and Judges Required

We need your help to compile a list of 6 pubs to go forward to our Amber Valley Cider Pub of the Year Competition. You have from **Friday 1st October to Saturday 30th October 2021** to submit **UP TO 5** Amber Valley pubs which must serve at least one real cider or perry on a regular basis and which you think deserve consideration. You don't have to list the pubs in order of preference and its fine if you only want to nominate one or two.

Please email your nominations to me at chairman@ambervalley.camra.org.uk along with your name and CAMRA membership number. You need to be an Amber Valley CAMRA member to nominate.

On **Sunday 31st October** the nominations will be counted and the 6 pubs with the most nominations will go forward to the competition which will be judged by volunteer CAMRA members **from Monday 1st November through to Tuesday 30th November**.

We would like to have as many judges as possible and, although they need to be members of CAMRA, they don't have to be Amber Valley Branch members. If you would be interested or know someone else who would, please contact me for more information. You only have to commit to visiting each of the 6 pubs once during the judging period and sending in your scoresheet by email or post.

A form listing the nominated pubs and the various categories to be judged, together with explanatory notes from CAMRA, will be sent to any member who volunteers to take part in the judging.

We thank you in anticipation for your input towards helping us to choose a worthy winner and runner up for this prestigious Branch award. The winner and runner up will be announced in **December** and the winner will go forward to the **East Midlands Regional Cider Pub of the Year Competition, starting in March 2022**.
